

## Sample Presentation Outline

Here's a sample presentation outline to help get you started. But don't forget, this is your story. Nobody can tell it better than you. Make this presentation your own — sharing your heart and how God has worked in your child sponsorship experience.

### Start with this ...

"Hi! My name is [your name]. It's so great to see everyone here. Today is Compassion Sunday. Christians in churches across the country are speaking out and sharing their story of child sponsorship on behalf of children living in poverty who are waiting. I want to share a quick video that shows the life of a child living in poverty, as well as the life-changing impact of Compassion child sponsorship."

### Share your story now ...

You could even share how your relationship has helped you better understand God, the Gospel and the verses in the Bible that talk about "speaking up" for those living in poverty.
